**\*\*SAT tests and semester exams may be made up only with a doctor’s excuse for illness. No exams will be given early. Please plan your schedules carefully.**

**First marking period: 42 days (interim has 22 days)**  
**Second marking period: 40 days (interim has 18 days)**  
**Third marking period: 45 days (interim has 22 days)**  
**Fourth marking period: 48 days (interim has 23 days)**

(Second semester contains SAT testing days, more field trips, etc., completing first semester before Christmas)

**First semester: 82 days**  
**Second semester: 93 days**

**Half days (5) at first day, Christmas break, winter break, spring break, last day.**

**Usually add one extra day to balance out the 5 half days and/or for a weather day, but did not do so this year due to extra day in March (late April spring break).**

**Check to be sure 2010 PSAT date is correct.**

**Note weirdness of: March break, late Spring break, SATs just prior to spring break, spring formal on Friday not Saturday, teacher workday after Memorial Day)**
