

RenWeb Sign-In Information

PCS communicates with parents via internet through RenWeb. Parents can view their student's grades, assignments, attendance, behavior reports, and account balances using this tool.

If you are a new user and need to log in for the first time to access RenWeb, follow these directions:

1. Go to www.renweb.com
2. Click on the silver Log-in tab on the top far right-choose Parents Web Log In
3. For the District Code, enter our school ID (PCS-AL), all caps & no parenthesis
4. As your username, enter your email address which you have previously provided to PCS
5. Next to Log In, click the create New Parents Web Account
6. A random password (which can be changed) will be emailed to you for your RenWeb parent account

If you do not receive your parent login password, be sure that www.renweb.com & @renweb.com are added to your "safe list". Also check your spam blocker/junk email. If you do not receive a password, please call the school to verify your email address in your school file.

Please remember to update any necessary changes throughout the school year in order for the office to have accurate information on your student.

To update important information such as a change of address, phone number, carpool pick-up, your child's medical information, etc., log on to RenWeb & under "School Information" click on the "Web Forms" tab. Then click "Family Demographic Form" and choose the appropriate tab to add or make changes. Be sure to scroll down to the bottom of the page and click on the "save" button.

***RenWeb Tips:**

If you experience any problems with RenWeb, try clearing your cookies or check your junk email to see if there are any messages received via RenWeb. If so, please add @renweb.com to your safe senders list by following these instructions:

1. On the Tools menu, click Options.
2. On the Preferences tab, under E-mail, click Junk E-mail.
3. Click the Safe Senders or Safe Recipients tab.
4. Click Add.
5. In the Enter an e-mail address or Internet domain name to be added to the list box, enter the name or address you want added, and then click OK.
6. Repeat steps 4 and 5 for each name or address that you want to add.

You can also add a sender's e-mail address or any other domain name to the Safe Senders List.
