GIRLS' Standardized Dress Selections (revised 12/11)

***Asterisk means item may be purchased anywhere as long as the item looks the same in style, length, color, & type fabric as the selections listed below.**

***Shorts** khaki/stone, navy

JCPenney pleated cotton/poly twill, flat or pleated front
Lands' End chino

- No shorter than 3-4 inches above knee
- No cargo pockets, rivets, corduroy, or drawstrings

***Pants** khaki/stone, navy

JCPenney pleated cotton/poly, flat or pleated front
Lands' End chino

- No cargo pockets, rivets, corduroy, or drawstrings
- No cargo pockets, cropped pants, rivets, corduroy or drawstrings

Skirt navy, khaki, plaid-hunter/classic navy

JCPenney all-around pleated or flat front; navy, khaki, plaid
Lands' End pleated, flat front chino, A-line 2 button

- No shorter than 3-4 inches above knee
- Bike shorts required underneath
- No cargo pockets, decorative metal, corduroy, or drawstrings

Skort khaki, navy

JCPenney scooter skirt, 100% poly; navy, khaki
Lands' End poly/cotton twill, chino

- No shorter than 3-4 inches above knee
- No cargo pockets, rivets, corduroy, or drawstrings

Jumper navy, khaki, **hunter/classic navy plaid**

JCPenney A-Line navy, khaki
Lands' End 2 button front or side pleated

- No shorter than 3-4 inches above knee
- **Plaid required for Special Day Dress**
- Bike shorts required underneath; no corduroy
- **Please note there is a similar Lands' End plaid with a different name—be careful when ordering to select hunter/classic navy.**

***Blouse, round collar** white, light blue

Lands' End cotton/poly blend or knit
JCPenney

- Short sleeve or long sleeve
- Ruffle or plain collar
- No logos except PCS crest

***Oxford shirt (button down)**

JCPenney button-down collar
Lands' End button-down collar

- White, light blue
- No logos except PCS crest
- Short sleeve or long sleeve

- * **Polo shirt** red, white, navy, light blue
 - No logos except PCS crest
 - Long sleeve or short sleeve

JCPenney cotton/poly
Lands' End cotton or interlock/mesh

- ***Turtleneck** red, white, navy, light blue
 - No logos except PCS crest

JCPenney cotton
Lands' End 100% cotton

- ***Sweaters** red, white, navy, light blue
 - Cardigan, v-neck, crew neck, vest, hoodie
 - No logos except PCS crest
 - Ruffle or plain front cardigan

Lands' End 100% cotton Drifter, cable, or fine gauge

- ***Sweatshirt**
 - Solid red, white, navy, light blue, gray
 - PCS logos only

Available for purchase through school in the fall

Friday T-shirts

Available for purchase through the school only

- Only PCS shirts in the grammar school standardized colors (red, navy, white, light blue, grey) sold through the school may be worn in the classroom on Fridays.
- **Please be aware that while you may order shirts or receive shirts of other colors (cheerleader, twirl, soccer clinics, etc.) through the school, only standardized colors will be allowed in the classroom.**

- ***Belt**
 - No decorative materials

Land's End; solid/braided, plain brown
Land's End Plaid D-ring belt (**Hunter Classic Navy Plaid only**)

- ***Under-jumper/skirt shorts**; navy, black

Lands' End bike shorts

- ***Socks/tights**
 - Red, white, navy ONLY
 - Socks/tights are required - **No skin tone hosiery except in 6th grade for Special Day Dress**

Lands' End socks, tights

***Shoes (closed toe only)**

For safety reasons, closed-toe shoes only with low heels. Heel straps required. **No boots of any type.** No platform shoes. No plastic, rubber, or decorated shoes, sandals, flip-flops, or pool shoes will be allowed. A plain Birkenstock style is permitted; heel strap required. **Nice casual or dress shoes for certain field trips.** Athletic shoes are fine for daily wear and are required for P.E.

Undershirts: T-shirts worn underneath standardized dress shirts must be solid, standardized colors of red, white, grey, or navy with no writing or design showing through the outer shirt or visible around the collar area. The sleeves or the bottom of an undershirt should not be visible.

Jackets: Any PCS outerwear/sportswear jacket may be worn. Any other jacket of solid red, navy, white, light blue, and gray with no exterior logos may be worn. No logos other than PCS are permitted on any garment. Jackets may not be denim material. Lands' End has heavier coats that follow this guideline.

GRAMMAR SCHOOL GIRLS SPECIAL DAY DRESS

Mandatory for all field trips and class presentations**

Warm weather: Plaid jumper or plaid skirt; white short sleeve blouse with round collar or white button-down oxford shirt; white socks with nice-looking closed toe shoes, with a flat heel.*** The 6th grade girls may wear skin-tone hose with flat heeled shoes.

Cool weather: Plaid jumper or plaid skirt; white long sleeve blouse with round collar or white button-down oxford shirt; navy cardigan, if desired; white socks or tights with nice-looking close toe shoes with a flat heel.*** The 6th grade girls may wear skin-tone hose with flat heeled shoes. Option from Sandra Jean Uniforms: Solid navy pant, (logo required) long sleeve white peter pan collar blouse (logo required). Red cardigan sweater (logo required).

Teacher will notify if Special Day Dress is NOT required. *Teacher may specify athletic shoes

GRAMMAR SCHOOL (GRADES 1-6) DRESS CODE GENERAL GUIDELINES

(The following guidelines are applicable for all school activities including special events such as Spirit week, class projects, athletic and play practices, etc.)

1. Students should arrive on campus in standardized dress and should remain in standardized dress until they leave campus. Students may not change clothes for an event occurring after school (dance class, etc) unless they are checked out by a parent and change clothes in the office. Students changing for sports practices should change and remain in the gym area.
2. No emblems, writing, or logos (except the PCS name and logo) are permitted on any garments.
3. Grammar school **skirts and jumpers** (which are to be worn with undershorts) must be **no shorter than 3 to 4 inches** above the top of the kneecap.
4. Grammar school **shorts and skorts** should be no shorter than 3 to 4 inches above the top of the kneecap.
5. The **rolling up** of the bottoms of garments, as well as the **rolling down** of waistbands, is NOT permitted.
6. The percentage of stretch, Lycra, or spandex in any garment should be not cause the garment to fit immodestly.
7. Baggy, oversized, or too tight-fitting clothing is not acceptable.
8. Pants/shorts/skirts are to be worn at the natural waist.
9. No drawstrings or rivets (decorative metal) on pants, shorts, or skirts. Please note the asterisk on the top of the front page.
10. All clothing should be neatly hemmed and without tattered or frayed areas.
11. **Standardized belts** for clothing with belt loops are MANDATORY.
12. All **shirt tails must be tucked in** unless a student is involved in P.E. or brisk, physical activity. The shirt tails should be re-tucked at the conclusion of the activity.
13. **Midriffs** should not be visible especially when hands are raised above the head.
14. If an undershirt is worn underneath another shirt, no writing or design may show through the outer shirt or be visible around the collar area.
T-shirt color is limited to solid, standardized dress code colors of white, true red, gray, light blue and navy. **The sleeves or the bottom of an undershirt should not be visible.**
15. Visible tattoos, body piercing (except ears of females), and heavy or unusual makeup, or distracting jewelry is not allowed when wearing standardized dress.
16. Hairstyles should always be neat, clean, and not distracting. This will be determined by administration.

NOTES:

1. Sweatshirts & caps are available only through the school at this time. Order forms will be sent home in the fall.
2. Please plan to wear Special Day Dress for all fieldtrips unless otherwise notified by your teacher. Parents should be aware that if their child is not wearing Special Day Dress, they may be called to bring the correct clothes to the school or their child may not be permitted to participate in the fieldtrip.

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3. Please be observant as to the wear and tear/fading of the garments and do not wear these garments to school. A worn-out appearance works against the goals of our dress code.
