

SOPHOMORE PLANNING TIMELINE

Fall:

- Continue to learn about yourself and find activities that you are interested in based on your values, talents and personality. Shadow in different vocational fields. This will give you the clearest picture of what people do in their occupations.
- Continue to ask broad questions...Christian College vs. Secular, Large vs. Small College, Public vs. Private University, Selective/Ivy League?
- Do your very best in school and get tutoring early on, if needed.
- Attend college representative visits and learn about different colleges.

Winter:

- Review course options and plan 11th grade classes based on interests/goals.
- Review resume and brainstorm ideas on interests or possible career plans. Continue adding activities and accomplishments to your student activity sheet.
- Brainstorm colleges you are interested and visit their admissions websites

Spring:

- Plan summer to include a job, ministry, or activity.

Summer:

- Research colleges admissions requirements and scholarships for GPA and ACT requirements
- Take a practice ACT to see how you perform on this test.
- If meeting goals for practice SAT, ACT or CLT, register for the actual test in Summer or early Fall.
- Continue to build a resume or take a summer class.
