

PROVIDENCE CHRISTIAN SCHOOL TUITION POLICY

Students are enrolled until graduation and the parent or guardian is responsible for the annual tuition payment each year on June 1. Two payment plan options are available through FACTS Tuition Management Company. Plans are automatically renewed each year the student is enrolled. An annual enrollment tuition deposit is required by March 10th to maintain the student's continuous enrollment (refundable only if a student is denied admission by the school or placed in a waiting pool).

Tuition refunds will be made only if the family is moving out of the area (50+ miles). For withdrawals between June 1 and August 1 tuition refunds will be prorated based on the withdrawal date.

Families enrolling during the current school year will pay prorated tuition based on the number of days in school.

The school reserves the right to deny a student's attendance for payments more than thirty (30) days delinquent. **Payment plans must be maintained in active status or student attendance will be affected.** School records and transcripts will not be released for any students enrolled under this contract until the account is paid in full.

Student Tuition Rates for 2020-2021

• Per student	7,500	7,800
○ Multi-student discount - Each additional student within the same family receives a \$600 multi-student discount.		
○ Annual Payment discount - Annual payments made by June 20 th receive an additional \$300 discount per student.		

Tuition rates include the \$200 tuition deposit per student due annually by March 10th.

Tuition includes textbooks, however, tuition does not include all costs which may be incurred by the family.

- **Construction/Maintenance Fee due annually per Family \$750*.**

**may be paid monthly with 12 payments beginning in June.*

- **New Student Application fee is \$225 and due with their application.**
- **Extended Day Program (EDP) Grades 1-6 is \$875** annually.**
- **Early Morning EDP is \$202.50** annually.**

***may be paid monthly with 9 payments beginning in September.*
