OVERVIEW

Founded in 1995, Providence Christian School is a ministry of First Presbyterian Church (FPC) in partnership with local families who share FPC's vision for classical, Christcentered education in Dothan, Alabama, and the surrounding communities. Beginning at our preschool, Providence Early Childhood, and through our Grammar, Logic, and Rhetoric schools at Providence Christian School, there are 777 students enrolled.

Providence's School Board is seeking to hire a Head of School to lead a robust and mature classical Christian school, K3-12th grade. With the faithfulness of the Lord combined with the generosity of past and present families, the current "Camp Meadow Wood" campus has provided a beautiful landscape to call home. Looking ahead, Providence forecasts a bright future with the recent purchase of 90 acres adjacent to its current property, ready for development and growth.

As an accredited classical Christian school, we value Truth, beauty, and goodness in all of life. In all of its levels, programs, and teaching, Providence strives to be Christ-centered and classical. We labor each day to train up a generation of courageous kingdom builders – citizens of excellence who observe, think, and articulate with humility, reason, and clarity for the glory of God.

As we partner with parents from a classical Christian approach, Providence operates with delegated authority (*in loco parentis*) from the parents (not the state or the church) to assist parents in fulfilling the responsibility for the education of their children. We are ordering a child's affections to something higher than themselves. Providence is encouraging students to become life-long learners, to notice anything excellent or praiseworthy, and to "think about such things."

HISTORY

Since **1973**, First Presbyterian Church has partnered with parents in the Wiregrass to provide a distinct education for students through Providence Early Childhood Ministries, located on the church campus, and celebrated the Preschool's 50th anniversary in **2023**.

In the early **1990s**, several Dothan families began to prayerfully seek a way to offer their children, in the grammar school years and beyond, the same quality, Christ-centered education they'd received at First Presbyterian Preschool. Prompted by God's leading and the enthusiasm of current and former Preschool families, the session of First Presbyterian Church made the decision in **1995** to start a classical, Christian school. In the course of a few weeks, God brought a very special team together who diligently worked to organize the start of Providence and the school year began in August with 56 students. Other Milestones:

The Cottage area, now called the Quad and home to our Logic students, initially housed all students and was completed with a total of nine cottages. It wasn't long before Providence grew beyond the Grammar school ages and graduated its first student in **2002**. Soon after, in **2003**, the multi-purpose gymnasium and academic building was completed. PCS joined the Alabama High School Athletic Association (AHSAA) in the **2004-2005** school year. Then a few years later, in **2007**, work was completed on a new Grammar school building that sits at the entrance to the campus.

In **2015**, Providence implemented a House System to provide the students an opportunity for mentorship, leadership, service projects, and intramural competitions. PCS was accredited by the Association of Classical Christian Schools (ACCS) at the beginning of the **2019-2020** school year, having been previously accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI). In **2021**, Providence acquired 90 acres adjacent to the current property and remains debt-free.



MISSION & VISION

MISSION: By God's grace, we are striving to be a school that impacts the entire family and encourages each student to become all that God calls him to be.

VISION: Equipping students. Following Christ. Changing the World.

Regarding both academic excellence and godly character development, our mission is, by God's grace:

- To promote principled thinking by helping each student develop a biblical worldview to be consistently applied to every area of life.
- To cultivate in each student a lifelong love of learning and pursuit of academic and moral excellence, for the purpose of bringing glory to God alone.
- To help train and equip each student to be a servant-leader who has an impact on those God puts within his reach, by living a God-honoring life.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

The following Statement of Faith, drawn from the Westminster Confession of Faith, defines the essential beliefs that guide the ministry of Providence Christian School:

Sovereignty of God: God sovereignly controls all that occurs in His world and in His Church. His plans and purposes always prevail; nothing can thwart them. (2) Ps 33:11, Eph 1:11, WCF Ch 3.1)

Inerrancy of Scripture: God's written Word, the Bible, is free from error and completely trustworthy. It is His Truth and the final authority in all matters. (Mt 5:18, 2Ti 3:14-17, WCF Ch 1.8-9)

God's Creation of the World and Man: The Triune God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, alone has existed from eternity past and in His wisdom decided to create the universe from nothing. God spoke and it came into existence. Humanity did not evolve from lower life forms, but was created by God. (Jn 1:2-3, Ge 1, WCF Ch 4) Mankind, male and female, was created with dignity in that they are made in God's image and created in humility in that their purpose is to glorify God and enjoy Him forever. In creating mankind male and female, God created them with distinct biological genders. Gender is both sacred and established by God's design. It is impossible to glorify God and enjoy Him forever while rejecting one's biological sex. (Ge 1:27, Ge 2:7, Ge 2; 22-23, WCF Ch 4.2)

The Family: God created the natural family as the fundamental, sovereign unit of society. God created the natural family to be a conjugal union of one man and one woman through marriage for the purposes of sharing love and joy, propagating children, and providing their moral education. Marriage was also given as a representation of the union between Christ and His Church. Any union other than a one-man, one-woman union for life is a violation of God's design and is therefore not a biblical marriage. (Ge 1:28, Ge 2:24, Eph 5:22-33, WCF Ch 24)

Fall of Mankind: All mankind participated in Adam's fall from his original sinless state and is thus lost in sin and totally depraved. (Ge 3:6-8, Ro 3:23, Ro 5:12, WCF Ch 6.1-3)

Jesus, Savior of Sinners: Jesus Christ is the unique Son of God and the only Savior of the World. He was born of a virgin and lived a sinless life. He purchased redemption by His substitutionary atonement on the cross. Jesus bodily rose from the dead, ascended to the right hand of the Father and He will come again in power and glory. (Isa 42:1, Jn 3:16, 1Pe 1:19-20, Heb 1:2, Heb 4:15, Lk 1:27-35, Ro 5:19, Php 2:8, 1Co 15:3-4, 1Pe 3:22, Ac 1:11, Mt 13:40-42, Mt 24:36-44, WCF Ch 8.1-4 & Ch 33)

Justification by Faith Alone: Sinners are justified by faith alone. They don't deserve salvation and they can't earn or work for it. Justification is totally due to God's grace and received by faith in Jesus Christ. (Ro 3:10-13, 22-28, Ro 4:5-8, Ro 5:15-16, Eph 2:8-9, WCF Ch 11.1-3)

Empowering Holy Spirit: Every true believer in Jesus Christ is indwelt and empowered by the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit enables believers to live a godly life and to perform good works. (2Co 3:18, Jn 15:4-6, Ro 8:4-14, Php 2:13, WCF Ch 13.3, 16.3)

Final Judgement and Resurrection: At the Second Coming of Christ, the saved and the lost will be bodily resurrected and judged. The saved are resurrected to eternal life and the lost are resurrected to eternal condemnation. (1Th 4:17, 1Co 15:51-52, Jn 5:22-29, Ac 24:15, 2Co 5:10, Mt 25:31-46, WCF Ch 32.2-3 & 33.1-2)



SENIOR THESIS Juniors and seniors are required to compose and deliver a lengthy argument based on original research. They must defend the thesis before a panel of faculty judges. Both the presentation and defense are open to the public.

FACULTY All faculty hold bachelor's degrees. Advanced degrees (MA, MS, PhD) include 13 of 23 Rhetoric; 4 of 7 Logic; 11 of 26 Grammar; and 2 of 4 Kindergarten faculty.

THE LOCATION

Dothan is nestled in the southeast corner of Alabama, just a few miles from both Georgia and Florida. Known as the "Peanut Capitol of the World", Dothan and surrounding communities produce 50% of the world's peanuts. Not far from Dothan, the beaches of the panhandle of Florida provide ready vacation spots.

Dothan has a small-town feel and southern charm; however, the population is 71,072, and Houston County is 108,079, according to the 2022 Census data. The Cost of Living index released by the Council for Community and Economic Research in 2024 gave the Dothan metro area a composite score of 87, which is 13 % less than the national index. For Alabama, Dothan provides one of the lowest cost-of-living locations in the state. In comparison, other scores include: New York City – 227, Boston – 148, Atlanta – 98, Huntsville – 93, and Birmingham – 91.

This community is a great place to raise a family. There are plenty of activities and events throughout the year in the arts, recreation, and sports. The City of Dothan is in the process of a new City Center downtown – a major investment in the revitalization of the heart of Dothan
